Torah Blessings

Before the Reading

Take your tallit or band, touch the Torah where the pointer is, touch it to your lips and recite:

ברכו את יי' המברך

Bar-khoo et A-do-nye ha-m'vo-rakh

Wait for the congregation to respond, and then you repeat:

ברוך יי' המברך לעולם ועד

Ba-rookh A-do-nye ha-m'vo-rakh l'o-lam va-ed

ברוך אתה יי' אלְהינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם אָשֵר בָּחרָ בְּנָנוּ מִכָּלְקָעַם וַיְנַתֵּן לָנוּ אֶת-תּוֹרָתוֹ. ברוך אתה יי' נוֹתֵן תּוֹרָה.

Ba-rookh a-ta A-do-nye E-lo-hay-noo me-lekh ha-o-lam, a-sher ba-har
ba-noo mee-kol ha-a-mim v'na-tan la-noo et to-ra-to. Ba-rookh a-ta
A-do-nye no-tayn ha-to-ra
