Before the Reading

Take your tallit or band, touch the Torah where the pointer is, touch it to your lips and recite:

בְּרָכוּ אֶת יְיָ הַמְבָרֵךְ

Bar-khoo et A-do-nye ha-m'vo-rakh

Wait for the congregation to respond, and then you repeat:

בָּרוּךְ יְיָ הַמְבָרֵךְ לְעוֹלָם וָעֶד

Ba-rookh A-do-nye ha-m'vo-rakh l'o-lam va-ed
